## Re-Image and Installation Preparation Procedure

This section refers to the Emergency Recovery Media provided with the **HP Z2-G4 Workstation Bundle PC for OpenLab CDS ChemStation** from Agilent.

The system will be set to the following configuration:

Edition:	Windows 10 Pro
Version:	1803
OS Build:	17134.1
System type:	64-bit operating system

CAUTION Irreversible loss of data will occur when re-imaging the computer!

### STEPS FOR RE-IMAGING THE PC

#### NOTE

We recommend unplugging any network cable before re-imaging.

If there is an active network connection the re-image process cannot be completed without entering a Microsoft Account. Network connectivity can be established later, also the Microsoft registration can be done later.

- 1 Plug the Recovery USB Flash Drive in the USB port before power-on.
- 2 Press the power button. Immediately press the Escape key repeatedly, about once every second, until the Startup Menu opens.
- 3 Choose Boot Menu (F9)

4 Choose the USB media, e.g. UEFI - SMI Corporation USB DISK...

NOTE: The actual name may defer from the example in this figure

- **5** The Windows 10 logo will be displayed, followed by a command line window. Enter the command **ApplyImage** there and press ENTER.
- 6 As a next step choose
  - a option 2 if the complete C: drive should be re-imaged as one partition, or
  - **b** option 1 if a C: and D: partition shall be set up.

In doubt choose option 2 (which means no D: partition) because if the user is not aware of the D: drive this could lead to this disk space remaining unused.

- 7 After completing 100% of re-image procedure (see percentage counting) type **exit** to reboot.
- 8 Complete the Windows Setup

### ΝΟΤΕ

Windows 10 Pro must be activated as follows: Once connected to the Internet, the activation may be triggered by Microsoft automatically after some time. Instead waiting for this event, you can actively press [Windows Key + R] to open a Run window. Type **slui 4**, and press **<enter>**.

Then choose your country and activate Windows by following the instructions provided.

9 Restart the Bundle PC to complete the setup script before doing the next steps!!

(This may take several minutes)

**10** Double-click the **Adobe** icon on the desktop, accept the license agreement and confirm Adobe Reader as the default PDF application (follow the instructions given > **Apply**)

The PC will now have a unique Device name (*DESKTOP-xxxxxx*). Decide if this name should remain or if there are other requirements e.g. from the local IT.

Now proceed with the ChemStation Installation following the instructions provided in the installation manual.
